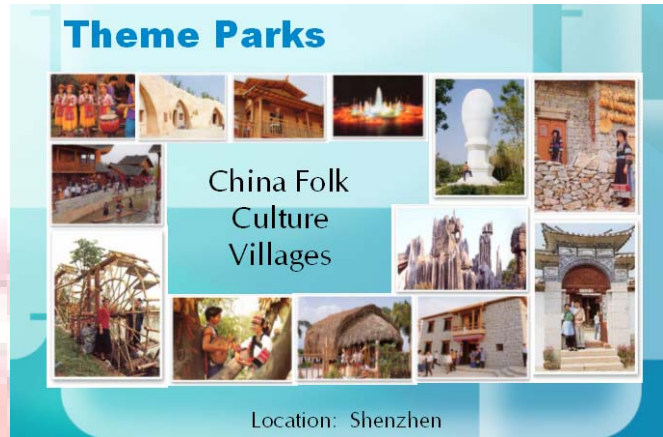
Shenzhen – Guangzhou Tour

Duration: 3 Days / 2 Nights (December 15, 2006)

Itinerary: Hong Kong – Shenzhen – Guangzhou – Foshan – Ping Zhou – Hong Kong

Day 1: Hong Kong – Shenzhen (Lunch and Dinner inclusive)

Meet and greet at the Train station and take the first-class train to Shenzhen. Explore the city with the comfy coach. Follow with a visit to the Terracotta Warriors and Horses exhibition. Spend the afternoon at the two of the most spectacular theme parks in Shenzhen – China Folk Culture Villages and Splendid China. Transfer to designated hotel after dinner.



Day 2: Shenzhen – Guangzhou (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included)

Meet and greet at the hotel lobby and transfer to the train station for the morning train to Guangzhou. Take our coach to Dr. Sun Yat-sen Memorial Hall and Chen Family Ancestors. Dr. Sun Yat-sen, the Father of Republic of China. The Chen Family Temple, also known as Guangdong Folk Art Museum, was built in the 1890s and has nine halls and six courtyards. Its windows, door frames, and pavilions are lavishly decorated with intricate carvings and sculptures. It is now the largest and best preserved and decorated ancient architecture existing in Guangdong province. Take the coach and transfer to rural Panyu and spend a short time walking around the Lotus Mountain. Have dinner at the local restaurant and transfer to designated hotel.



Day 3: Guangzhou – Foshan – Ping Zhou – Hong Kong (Breakfast and Lunch included)

Transfer to Foshan in the morning and visit the Foshan Ancestral Temple with eight centuries of history. Then, a visit to the ceramics workshop and a folk art studio for delicate handicrafts, where Foshan's most spectacular handiwork can be found. Follow with a visit to Liang's Garden where you can find the most magnificent Stone Scriptures. Transfer to Pin Zhou Pier and take the catamaran back to Hong Kong.



China Heritage Tour

Duration: 6 Days / 5 Nights (December 15, 2006)

Itinerary: Hong Kong – Beijing – Xian – Hong Kong

<p>Day 1: Hong Kong – Beijing Meet and greet at the Hong Kong International Airport and take the flight to Beijing. Have a short city tour upon the arrival. Transfer to designated Hotel and enjoy your free-leisure time to explore the city by visiting the Night Market. Dinner at your own arrangement.</p>	
<p>Day 2: Beijing (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included) Today, take an excursion to the Great Wall, the longest man-made object in the world. The 6,350km Great Wall was first constructed in the 7th BC and extensions were done repeatedly in later dynasties. It is another UNESCO-endorsed cultural heritage site. Enjoy the dramatic vistas and marvel at the Wall as it climbs and descends steep ridges and narrow valleys. Visit the Summer Palace in the afternoon. It is the best-preserved imperial garden in China and was endorsed by UNESCO in 1998 as a world cultural heritage site. Following to Lao She Tea House to enjoy a taste of the art of brewing and drinking fragrant Chinese tea, accompanied by a performance by local fold artists is an additional.</p>	
<p>Day 3: Beijing (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included) Enjoy a pedicab tour of Hutongs, the “old city” neighborhoods of narrow alley ways and courtyard gardens hidden behind Beijing’s modern façade. Then, guests will then be taken to the Forbidden City, the imperial palace for the Ming and Qing dynasties built between years 1406 – 1420. Visit Tiananmen Square, one of the world’s largest city squares which is large enough to hold 1 million people. Afterward, visit the Tiananmen Gate on the northern edge of the square used to be the front gate of the Ming and Qing Imperial Palace. Guests will be taken to the rostrum atop the gate, where national leaders review mass rallies or gala celebrations on important occasion, for a bird’s eye view of the Square. Enjoy a Peking Duck banquet to finish off the day.</p>	
<p>Day 4: Beijing – Xian (Breakfast and Lunch included) Take the journey to Temple of Heaven, the largest temple complex and a UNESCO endorsed site. The Temple was built in 1420 and was the place where the Ming and Qing emperors prayed for good harvests for their kingdoms. Transfer to Beijing Airport and take the flight to Xian, a city with a history of 3,000 years. If there is time available, a short city tour will be provided. Transfer to designated Hotel and enjoy your free-leisure time to explore the city by visiting the Night Market. Dinner at your own arrangement.</p>	
<p>Day 5: Xian (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner included) In the morning, discover the unique, world-famous Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum. Terracotta Warriors, is said to be Qin Shihuang’s Army 2000 years ago and it is built to protect the grave of the king. In the afternoon, visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda, with the history of ten centuries, it is the best reserved Pagoda in Xian.</p>	
<p>Day 6: Xian – Hong Kong (Breakfast and Lunch included) In the morning, take the tour to the City Wall and then travel to the fascinating Great Mosque in Xian’s Muslim Quarter. Transfer to the Xian Airport and take the flight to Hong Kong.</p>
